Headband for EEG BE-090AS, BE-090AM

General

The BE-090AS and BE-090AM headbands are for attaching electrodes for EEG monitoring. The headband is used mainly in an ER or ICU.

Safety Information

Do not use a deteriorated headband. If the headband is deteriorated, replace it with a new one. If a deteriorated headband is used, measurement may be incorrect.

Do not attach the headband to the patient in the lateral recumbent position because it puts too much pressure on the head.
